(Matthew 13:24–30)

2. What’s one small thing God may be growing in me right now that I’ve been overlooking because it seems insignificant?
(Matthew 13:31–33)

3. If God’s kingdom is really more valuable than anything else, what would it look like for me to live like I believe that?
(Matthew 13:44–46)

4. Which parable or moment in this passage hits me the hardest personally, and why?
(Matthew 13:34–52)

5. Have I ever become so familiar with Jesus or church that I stop expecting Him to really change me?
(Matthew 13:53–58)
