The aim of the **Creative Arts Internship** is to invest in and train up leaders that will be ready for vocational ministry in the areas of music, arts and media.

Our desire is to invest in the whole leader; spiritually, relationally and professionally. It is our heart that you will not only grow in your gifts and abilities, but that you will be equipped to train and lead others - and be prepared to answer the call of God wherever it may lead you.

YEAR 1

QUARTER 1

Objective: SERVE. You'll serve and see the heart behind the ministry. We would like students to get a feel for every area on the team.

- Serving every Sunday on one of our CA teams (both campuses, flexible)
- Rotate through each of our eight serving areas and gather a general knowledge of each position

QUARTER 2

Objective: LEARN. Learn the *how* for your area of interest, as well as, gain a general knowledge of each area within Creative Arts. Also, build relationships with mentors and team members.

- Learn editing, capturing footage, videos, etc.
- Co-lead, observe sets, attending team planning scheduling meetings
- Learn systems: How does everything work, CA language, communications. How do I communicate with the sound guy? The band? Content team behind-the-scenes, etc.
- Learn scheduling
- Bring a devotional on Sunday's to our team. (this is a great discipleship opportunity)
- Cohort meeting 1x/month CA Specific (we'll cover leadership cohort curriculum)

QUARTER 3

Objective: DO. Begin to take what you've earned and put it into practice. In this quarter you will be creating,

producing and publishing content for supporting ministries and general ministries of Stone.

- Produce content. Make videos. Take/edit/publish photos
- Create lighting scenes (Ex: Worship Night)
- Help craft sets: begin understanding and implementing our team schedules
- Lead
- Band Directing
- Produce stems for sets (create tracks for youth and Sunday mornings)

QUARTER 4

Objective: TRAIN. Fluently communicate with individuals and recruit and train. This is where you as a student become a leader. During this quarter, you must identify one person to take through this process during your second year of the program.

- Plan/produce/execute a Worship Night (does not mean you're leading it, but you design and orchestrate it)
- Produce additional services (Ex: SCY... create lighting, produce worship set, run audio, take photos, and produce videos for SCY, KIDS etc.)
- Recruit – you'll have leadership responsibility of recruiting, and becoming a soft mentor to the person you recruit

YEAR 2

QUARTER 1

Objective: SERVE

- Rooted in a specific campus.
- Take someone through the first-year process of *SERVE*

QUARTER 2

Objective: LEARN

- Begin leading teams
- Take someone through the first-year process of *LEARN*

QUARTER 3

Objective: DO

- Run services, tracks, and handle scheduling for your respective campus

- Take someone through the first-year process of *DO*
- What does it look like for you to dream, plan, execute a creative ministry not yet developed at Stone?

QUARTER 4

Objective: TRAIN

- Take someone through the first-year process of *TRAIN*
- Be equipped and ready for ministry. At this point, you are well positioned to take on a lead role in your area of expertise whether your goal is to serve as a lay leader - or as a part-time or full-time Creative Arts employee
