

People gnawed their tongues in agony and cursed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, but they refused to repent of what they had done. The sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates,

impure spirits that looked like frogs; they came
out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the

false prophet. They are demonic spirits that perform signs, and they go out to the kings of the whole world, to gather them for the battle on the great day of God Almighty. "Look, I come like a thief!

Revelation 16:1-20

Blessed is the one who stays awake and remains clothed, so as not to go naked and be shamefully exposed." Then they gathered the kings together to the place that in Hebrew is called Armageddon

3. Examples of God's Judgment and Wrath

Old Testament

The Flood (Genesis 6–9) – Widespread corruption led to global judgment.

Sodom and Gomorrah (Genesis 19) – Cities destroyed for extreme wickedness.

The Plagues of Egypt (Exodus 7–12) – God's wrath on Pharaoh's hard heart and Egypt's oppression.

Exile of Israel and Judah (2 Kings 17, 2 Chronicles 36) – Sent into exile for covenant unfaithfulness.

New Testament

Jesus' Teachings (Parables in Matthew 25) – Warnings of judgment.

God "gives them over" to their sins (Romans 1–2) - A form of present judgment.

Ananias and Sapphira (Acts 5) – Immediate judgment for lying to the Holy Spirit.

Revelation (Revelation 6–19) – God's wrath poured out in end-times judgments.

Justice

Romans 2:5-6

**God's wrath is in line
with perfect justice.**

Patience

2 Peter 3:9

**Wrath is delayed to
allow repentance.**

Atonement

Romans 3:25

**Jesus bore God's wrath
so we could be justified.**

Deliverance

1 Thess. 1:10

**Believers are rescued
from the coming wrath.**

Bowl 1 – Painful Sores

"The first angel went and poured out his bowl on the land, and ugly, festering sores broke out on the people who had the mark of the beast and worshiped its image."

Bowl 2 – Sea Turns to Blood
