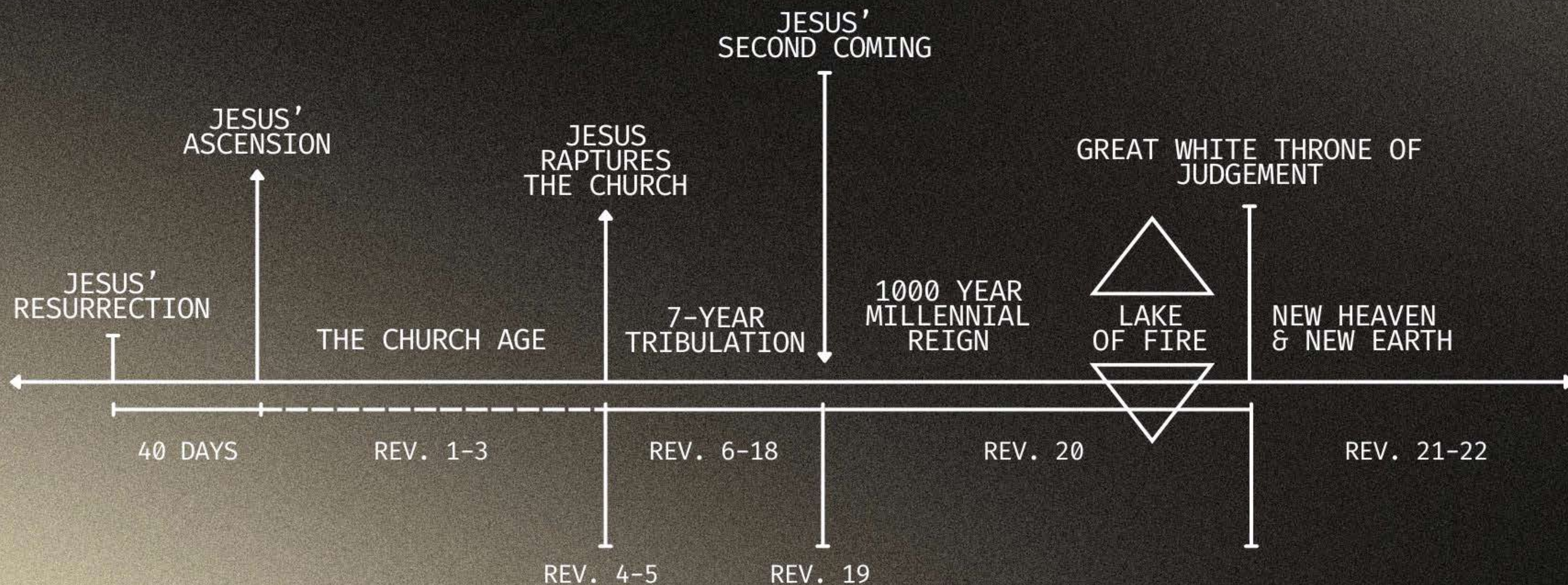

REVELATION 18:9–20

“Every sea captain, and all who travel by ship, the sailors, and all who earn their living from the sea, will stand far of . When they see the smoke of her burning, they will exclaim, ‘Was there ever a city like this great city?’

They will throw dust on their heads, and with weeping and mourning cry out: " 'Woe! Woe to you, great city, where all who had ships on the sea became rich through her wealth! In one hour she has been brought to ruin!'
